Our Assistance Program has limited amount of funds to distribute and our program depends on donations and the generosity of our Parishioners. Not all applicants that apply will receive help.

By applying for assistance, the applicant authorizes the members of the St. Joseph Community Assistance Program to contact the utility company and/or landlord or any other person to facilitate payment of the bills or other assistance. The applicant should understand that false or misleading information in their application or interview will result in refusal of assistance.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE CHURCH OFFICE

Do not call the church office to check on the status of your request for assistance. We will notify you of the assistance provided once all documentation is verified. For urgent matters, please call the St. Joseph Community Assistance phone line 501-329-6305. All calls to the phone lines will be returned as soon as possible.

Individuals or families can receive assistance through the St. Joseph Community Assistance Program two times in a 12 month period. If you or someone at your address has already received assistance from St. Joseph Community Assistance Program, you will not be eligible for further assistance. Please contact one of the additional resources that we have provided.

Items needed for Summer Crisis / Regular Assistance Program:

- ∞ Copy of Most Recent Electric Bill or Shut-Off/Discount Notice
- ∞ Proof of Prior Month income or “History of Claims” for anyone in the household
18
Years of age or older
 - If anyone has worked the previous month that they apply for Assistance, they must provide ALL check stubs for that month.
 - If anyone has not worked the previous month, they MUST Obtain a “History of Claims” from the Department of Workforce.
 - Proof of school/ college schedule for anyone 18 years of age or older that is in school & not working (*if applicable*).
- ∞ Social Security Numbers & Date of Birth for ALL household members
- ∞ Proof or lack of Child Support
- ∞ Other benefits received: SSS / VA / SS / TEA / UNEMPLOYMENT
